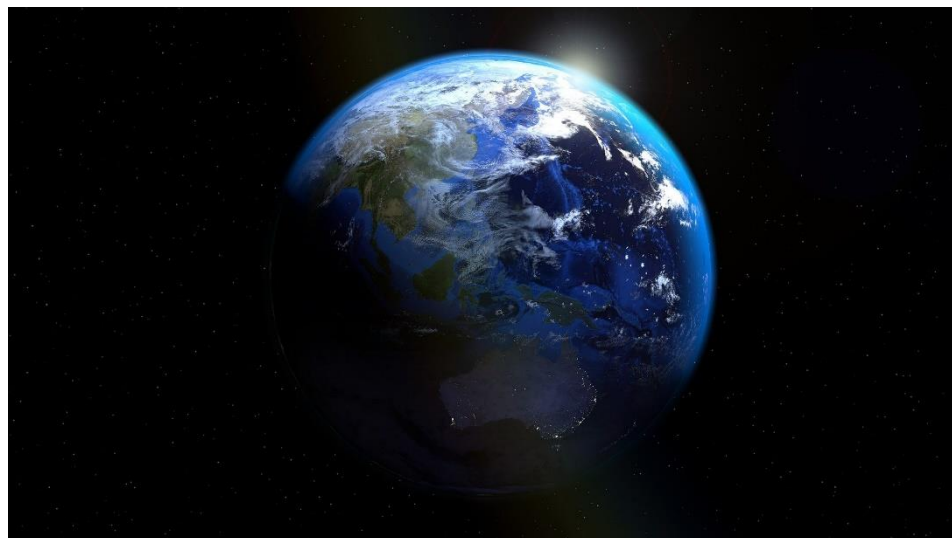



AGH UST – Education offer

AGH UST offers studies at three levels (cycles) of education, according to the Bologna System:

- first-cycle degree programmes (6-7 semesters) lead to awarding a bachelor's degree,
- second-cycle degree programmes (3-4 semesters) lead to awarding a master's degree,
- third-cycle degree programmes – doctoral studies – prepare students to teach and conduct independent research, and lead to awarding a doctor's degree.

Qualification process – exchange student

STEP I

Visit the AGH UST Department for International Students at www.international.agh.edu.pl

STEP II

Check (with your university) if there is a **bilateral agreement** between AGH UST and your university

STEP III

Follow the qualification procedures of your International Office

STEP IV

Make sure that a nomination from your home university is sent to AGH UST

STEP V

Follow the qualification procedures of AGH UST sent by the Department for International Students

Candidates for:

1st cycle degree programmes (Bachelor) - pass the on-line language examination or upload the certificate

2nd cycle degree programmes (Master)-pass the on-line entrance examination

In case of acceptance **register for studies** at AGH UST Department for International Students office and **submit the originals** of required documents

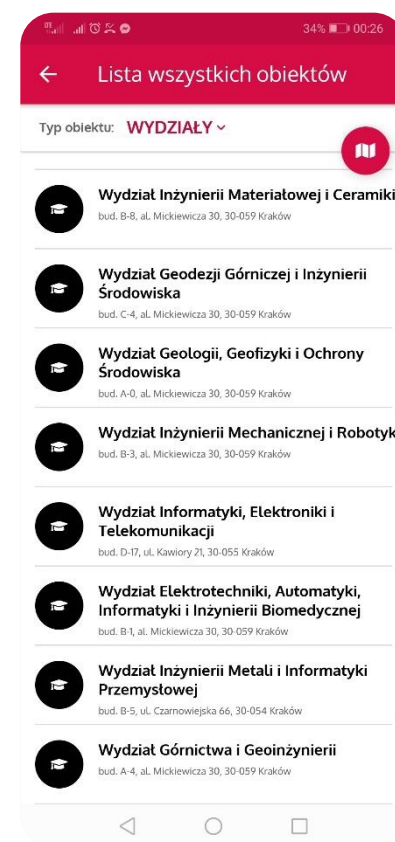
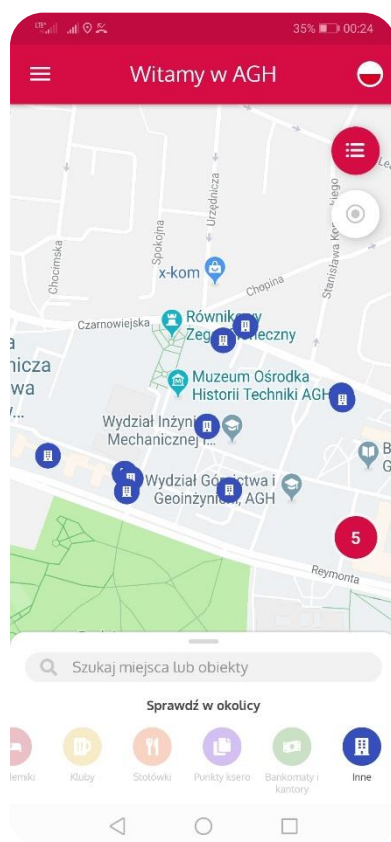


Locations of faculties, student clubs, canteens and other premises



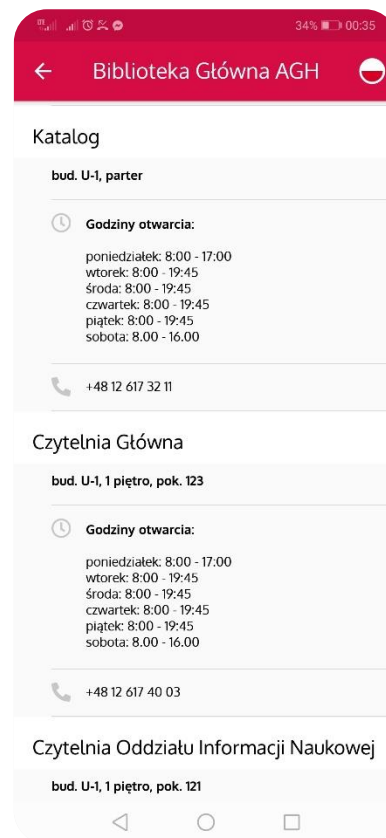

Nocna i świąteczna opieka zdrowotna to świadczenia w zakresie podstawowej opieki zdrowotnej udzielane od poniedziałku do piątku w godzinach od 18.00 do 8.00 dnia następnego oraz całonocowo w dni ustawowo wolne od pracy.

W razie nagłego zachorowania lub nagłego pogorszenia stanu zdrowia pacjent może udać się po pomoc do dowolnego punktu nocnej i świątecznej opieki zdrowotnej, niezależnie od tego, gdzie mieszka, i do którego lekarza/pielęgniarki podstawowej opieki zdrowotnej (POZ) złożył swoją deklarację.

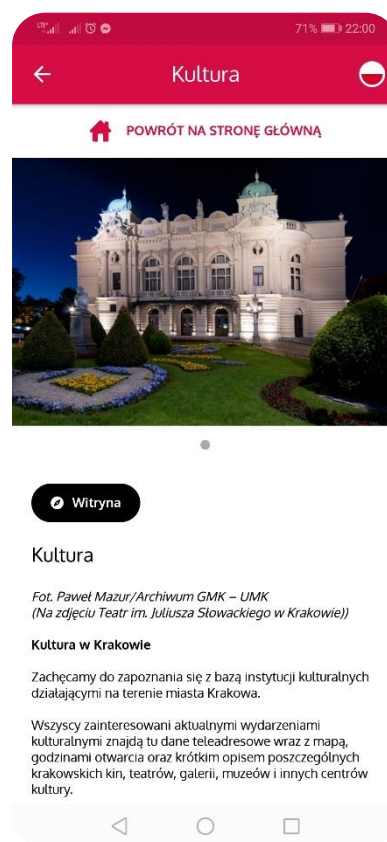
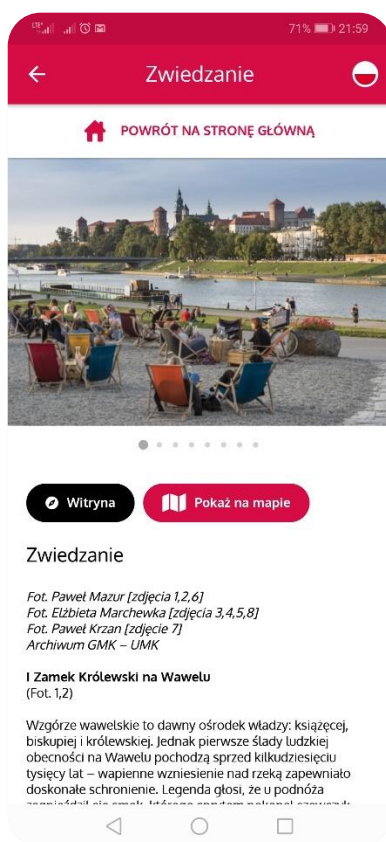
