





EXCHANGE SEMESTER

- Courses taught in English at the master's level (4th and 5th year)
- Students from all over the world: many Erasmus students (about 60 per year)
- An international association in contact with exchange students throughout the semester to help them at the IPSA and in Paris and to organize activities
- A French buddy is assigned to each exchange student
- French classes every Thursday afternoon for all exchange students

 1 academic year at Bachelor's level (taught in French) in Paris or Toulouse








CAMPUS LIFE
