Founded in 1477

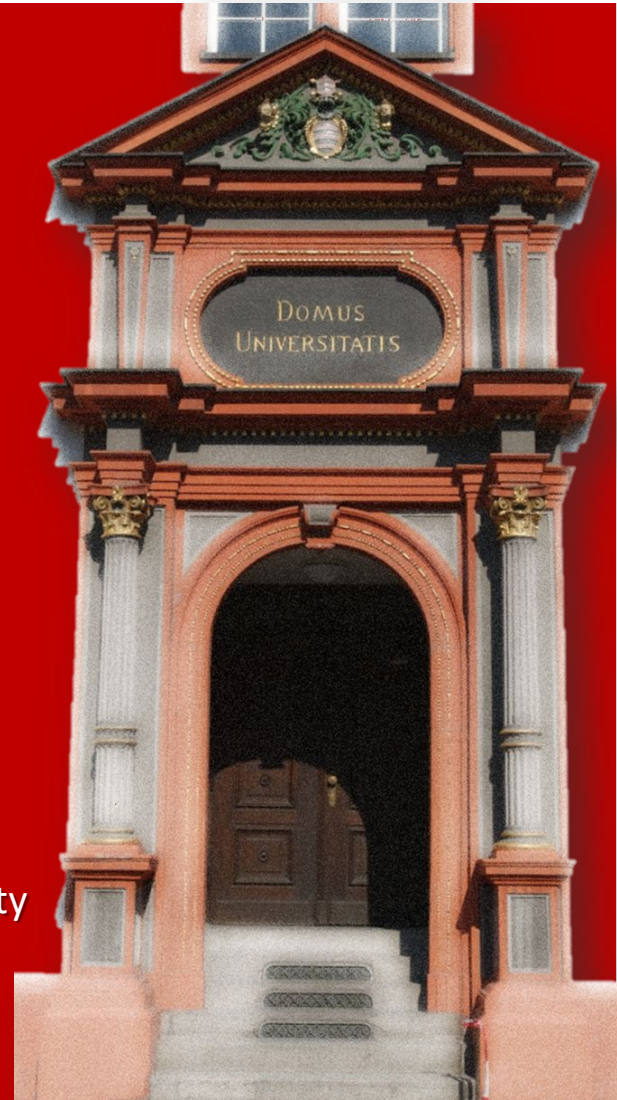

World-renowned inventor of the printing press with movable type and the most famous son of the city of Mainz



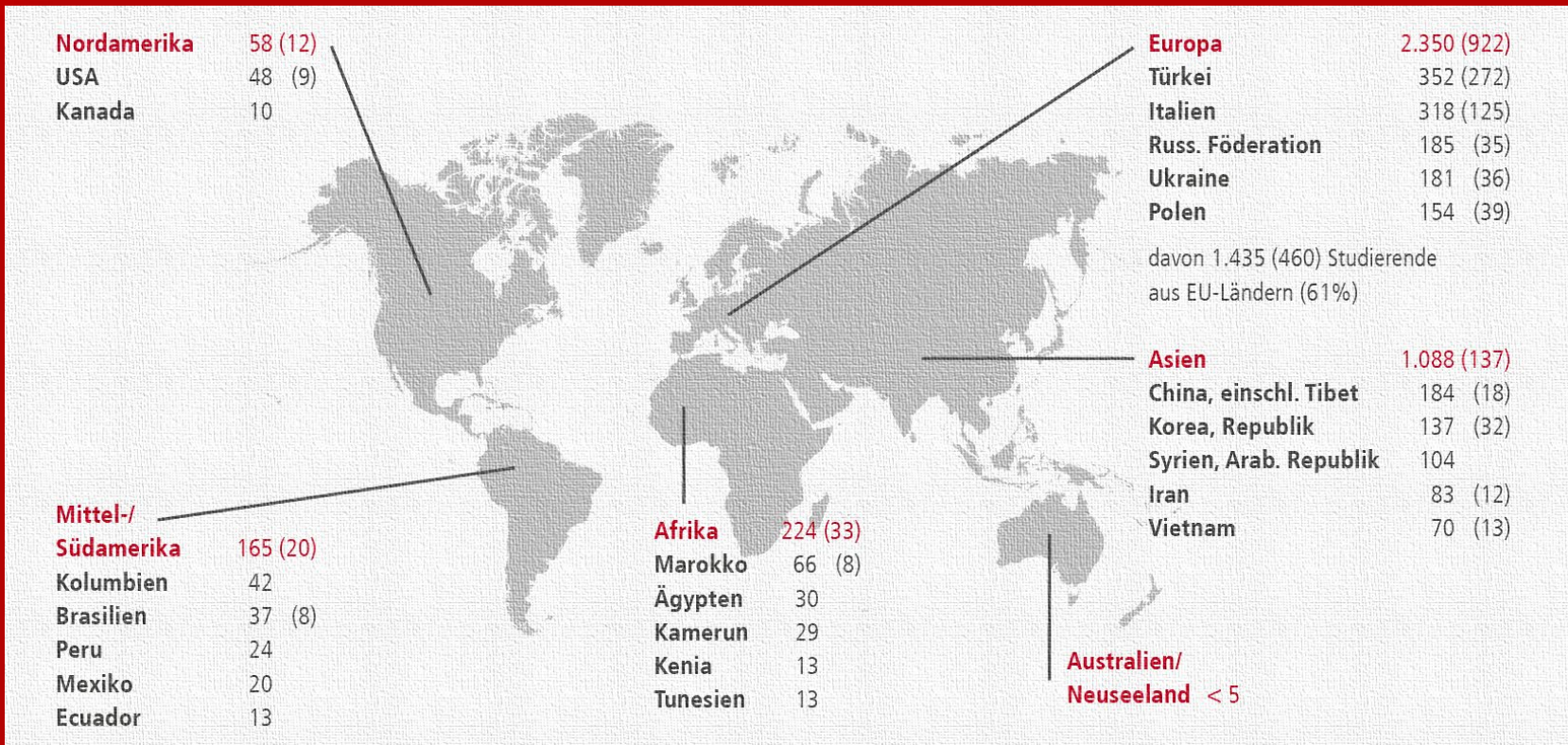

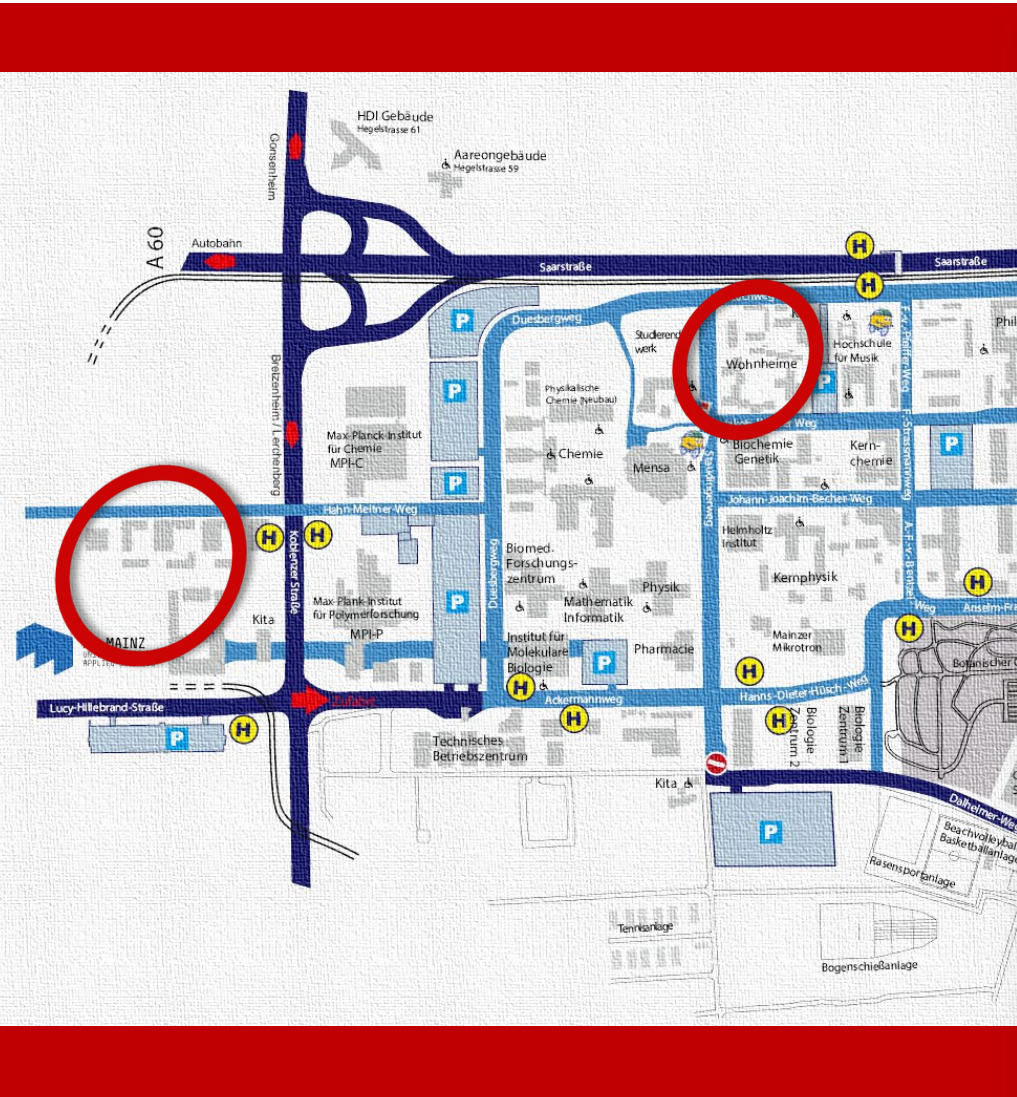
