- Home to a magnificent nature with all shades of green and blue


TRABZON

 Trabzon has been an important centre of cultural interaction, since it was located on the historical trade route, the Silk Road.


 Cultural heritage of many civilisations such as the Romans, the Greeks, and the Ottomans




ST. SOPHIA MUSEUM (AYASOFYA)

- Approximately 40,000 students and more than 215,000 graduates









