
University, city and environment

Last but not least: Fees

We are a public university. Part of the real costs of university fees are subsidized.

Estimated fees for europeans:

- Undergraduate: ~1000 €/year
- Master: ~2000 €/year
- Doctorate programme: ~200 €/year

Estimated fees for non-europeans:

- Undergraduate: ~1000 €/year
- Master: ~ 6000 €/year
- Doctorate programme: ~ 300 €/year
