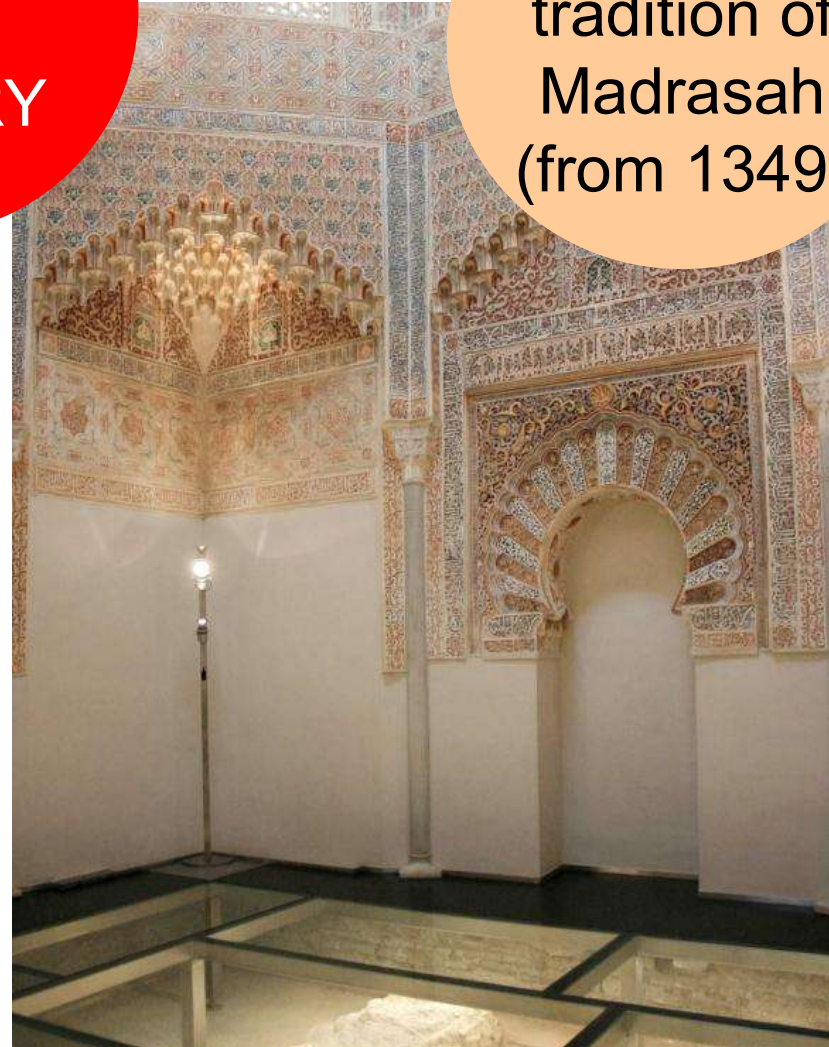

Social life and cost of living

The city of Granada offers you many *cultural possibilities*: flamenco festivals, jazz, tango, theatre, magic, music, dance,...



Spanish *food is internationally recognized* for its quality and variety and Granada is known for its “tapas”. Besides, Granada is considered one of the *cheapest cities in Europe* to live as a student.



reasons to work with the UGR

Last but not least: Fees

We are a public university. Part of the real costs of university fees are subsidized.

Estimated fees for europeans:

- Undergraduate: ~**1000 €/year**
- Master: ~**2000 €/year**
- Doctorate programme: ~**200 €/year**

Estimated fees for non-europeans:

- Undergraduate: ~**1000 €/year**
- Master: ~ **6000 €/year**
- Doctorate programme: ~ **300 €/year**
