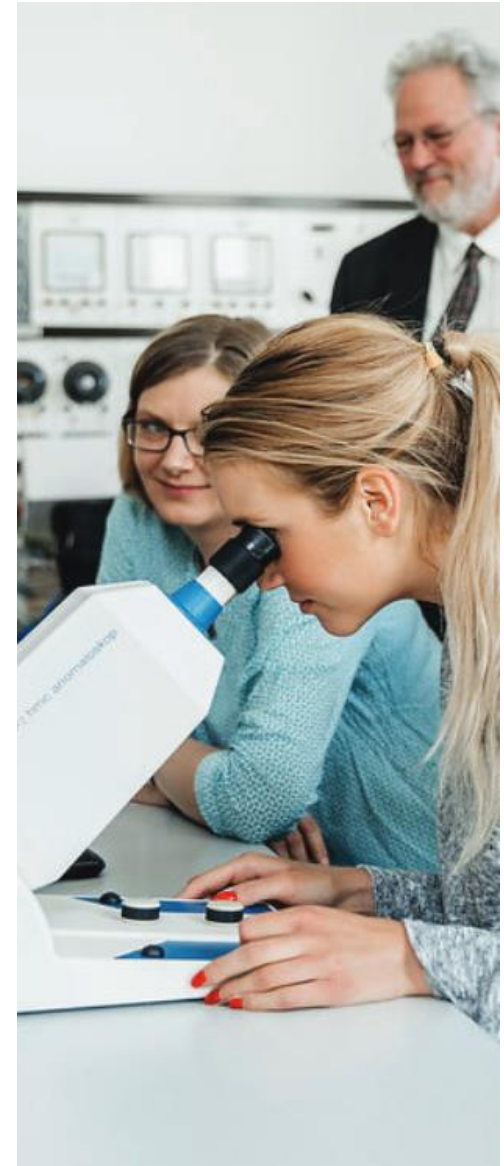


Exchange semester – courses in German

The teaching language for almost all study programmes is **German** and a language level of at least B1/B2 (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) is required.

The Erasmus+ agreement between HTWK and KTU offers the following options:

- provides exchange students with excellent opportunities to get to know the university and to meet their fellow students

Housing

- affordable furnished rooms in student residence halls provided by *Studentenwerk Leipzig*
- 2 person apartments offer single rooms for students with a shared bathroom and kitchen area
- Student residence halls are situated close to campus via public transportation
- approx. 220 Euro per month, plus an additional 300 Euro refundable security deposit

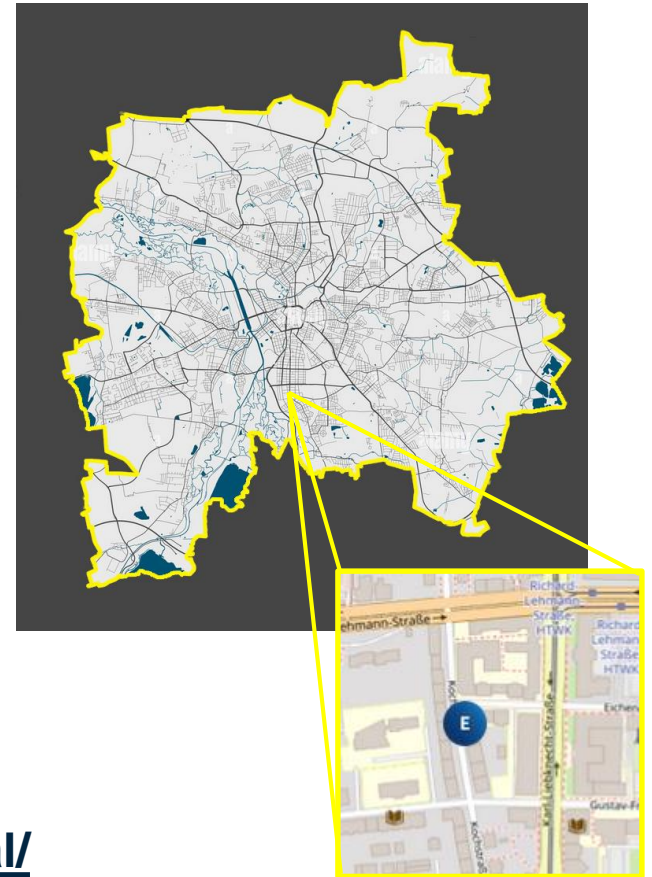
