

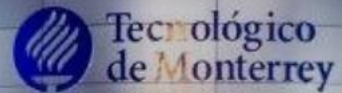

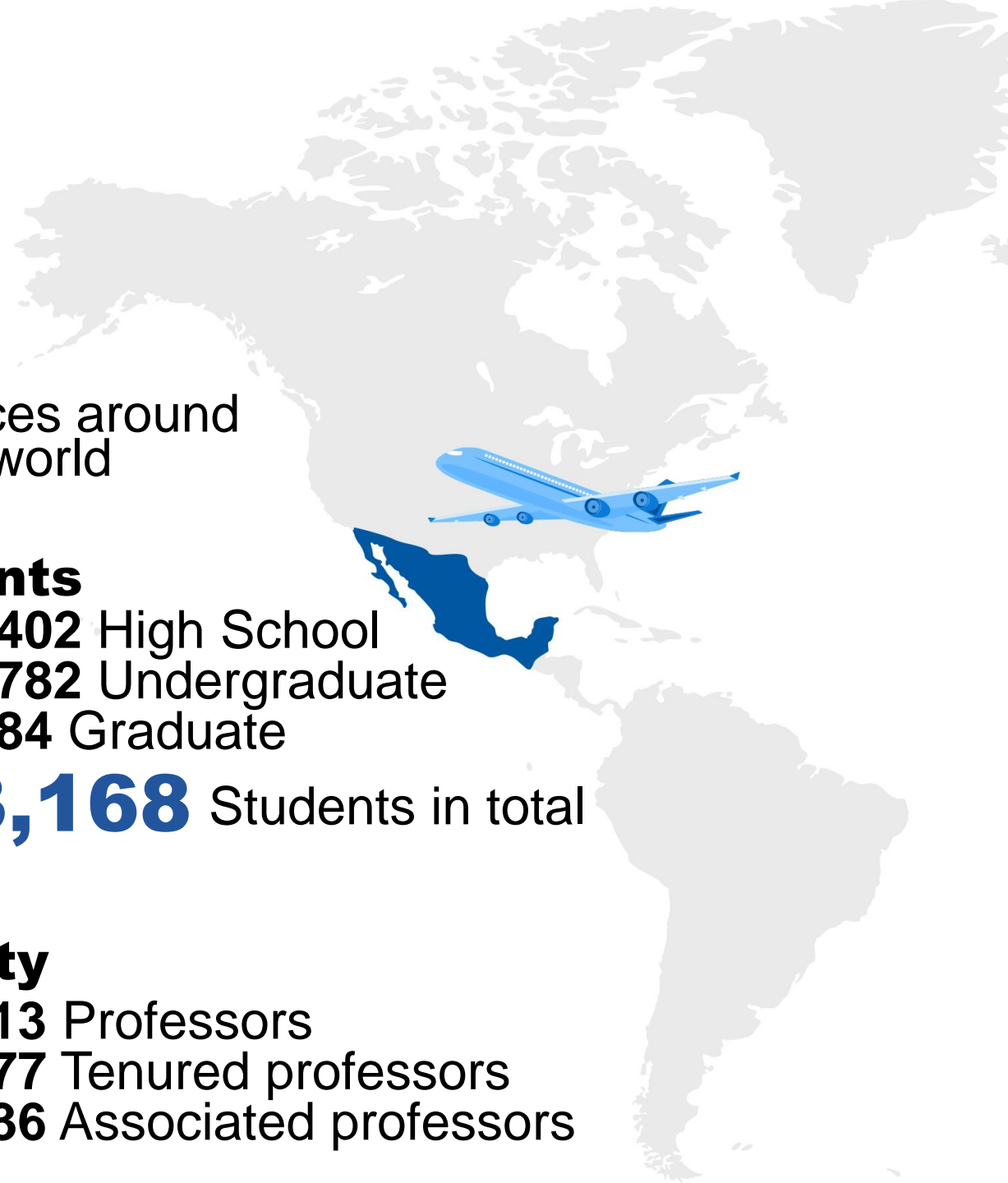

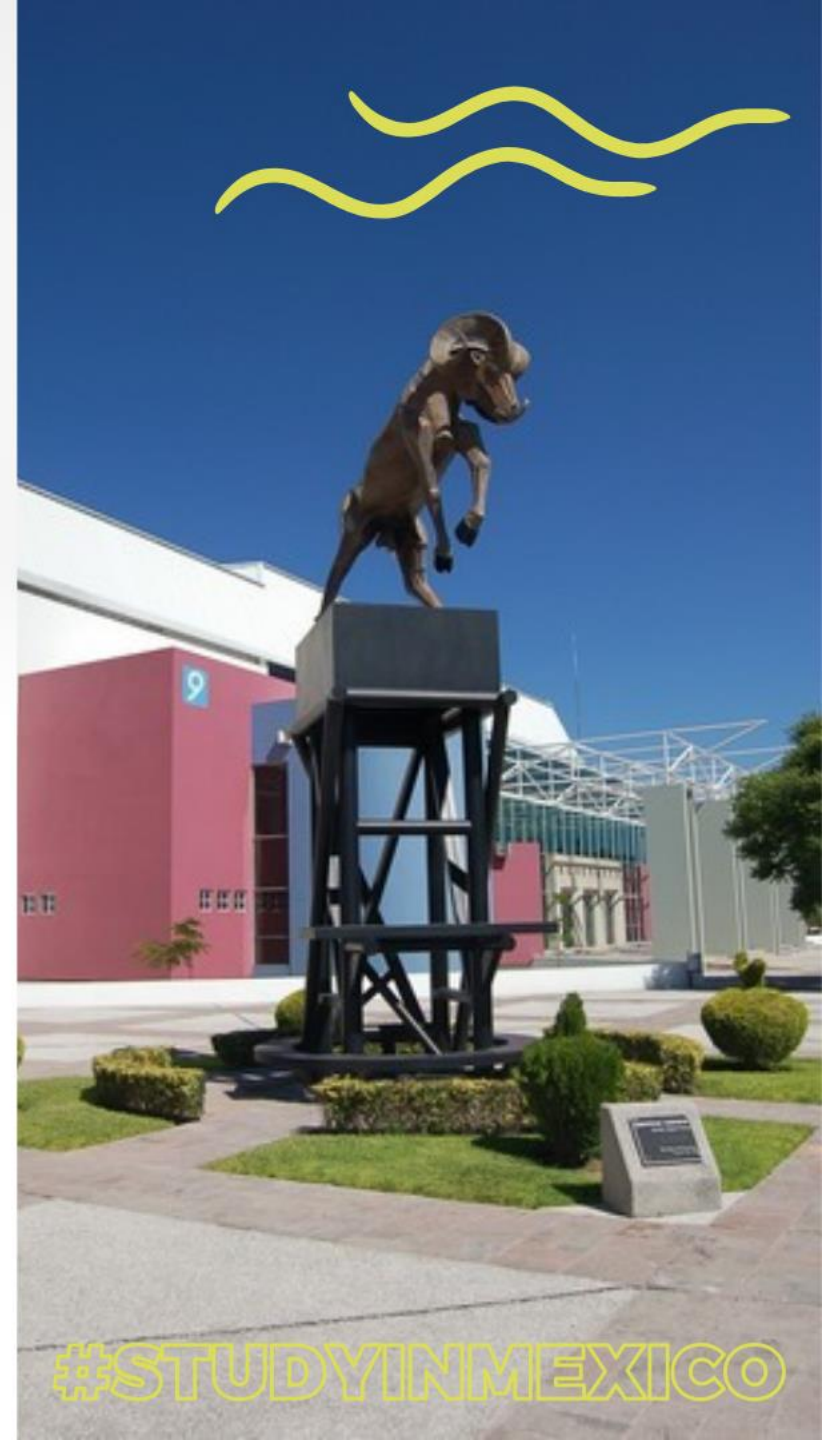

Tec de Monterrey [Campus Monterrey](#) is TEC's [first largest campus](#) in Mexico. It has [6 buildings](#) or "aulas" that host multiple classrooms, labs, workshops, and auditoriums.

International students have free access to the [sport facilities](#) such as: Well-equipped gymnasium, athletic track, indoor swimming pool, tennis, basketball and volleyball courts.

TEC offers [free transportation](#) to the main streets of neighboring areas surrounding the campus. This circuit cover approximately 10 neighboring areas to the Campus Monterrey and you can take [Circuito Tec](#) every 20 minutes

TEC Campus Querétaro



Tec de Monterrey **Campus Querétaro** is TEC's **fourth largest campus** in Mexico, 51% of its students are from outside Querétaro and we receive students from more than **23 countries** every year.

Its modern facilities are distinctive and in addition, it is located in the **heart of the city**, only 15 minutes away from the Historic Center!

The campus has stops for public transport (**Qrobus**) and the public bicycle system (**Qrobici**). Also, TEC has a Safe Taxi system available in the main booth, as well as **“TransporTEC”** for students who around the university.

TEC Campus Guadalajara



The Campus Guadalajara is located at the west of Zapopan, along 37 hectares. Our student community is compound of over 8,000 students and every year we receive around 600 international students from different countries.

Its modern facilities are distinctive suchs as library, classrooms, outdoor facilities, parking lot, Auditoriums and a Congress Centre, sports areas, residences & cafeterias.

Within the sports offering you can find different options of classes taught on Campus. Some of them take place within the gym area.

The campus has stops for public transport, and their official "EXPRESO TEC" that reaches specific routes directly with Tec in a safe service.

TEC Campus Mexico City



Located in the Southern part of the City, Mexico City Campus is the 2nd biggest campus when it comes to student population with around 8,000 students each semester.

Though the facilities are currently being rebuilt, they contain anything students might need to live a full University Experience. The total area of the Mexico City Campus will be of 24 hectares.

Temporary facilities provide with more than 200 classrooms available and areas designated specifically for labs, studios, sports & cultural activities. Such as library, learning commons areas, gym, sports fields & courts, cafeterias, and food courts.
