



#### **Course Selection Regulations for Exchange Students**

- Minimum credits to obtain: 3
- Maximum credits to obtain: 25
- Exchange students can choose courses from different departments/institutes, colleges and study levels.
- 5 course selection phases for students to arrange their courses
  - 1) Preliminary Course Selection (before semester starts), 2) Add & Drop (I),
  - 3) Add & Drop (II), 4) Exceptional Circumstances, and 5) Withdrawal

#### **Credit Transfer**

- Every 18 class hours is counted as 1 credit.
- A 3-credit course will be a 3hrs class per week.

### Course Features

- Free Chinese language course 4 hrs per week (3 credits)

### Quarantine Measures

- Present a PCR Report done within 2 days before boarding
- Take another PCR test upon arrival
- Stay in a quarantine hotel for 16 nights (complete a rapid test and PCR test during the period) - each person stays in a room by themselves / can't go out of the room during the period
- Stay in a regular hotel for 6 nights for Self-health Management each person stays in a room by themselves / can go out of the room to buy food and necessities
- Around NT\$36,660 (1,150 EUR / 1,320 USD) including the transportation fee,
   the hotel fee, and PCR test administration fee.

# Approximate Living Cost

- Dorm Fee: NTD 8,500~17,000 / semester
- Campus Wi-Fi & Internet Fee: NTD 300 / semester
- Group Insurance Fee: NTD 329 / semester
- Books: NTD 5,000 / semester
- Meals: NTD 9,000-12,000 / month
- Local Transportation: NTD 500-1,000 / month

Estimated cost for 5 months: 2,000-2,750 EUR (US\$2,250 - 3,150)
