

WHO CAN APPLY?

Eligible applicants should:

Hold a passport from Estonia, Latvia or Lithuania

Be enrolled at an accredited postsecondary university and be in the final year. And their graduation time is expected in 6 months after Application Deadline

OR have graduated within 6 months of Application Deadline OR be enrolled on a full-time basis at an accredited postgraduate university, e.g. Masters, Ph.D.

Agree to return to your home country for a minimum of two years immediately post-scholarship

APPLICATION

Application form and list of required documents on BAFF website

BEACON – application system on-line

Selection process in two stages

Application deadlines twice a year: March 31 and October 31
