People with disabilities (physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairments which may prevent full and effective participation in community life on an equal basis with others).	Disability certificate or other official document justifying a disability that may prevent full and effective participation in community life under the same conditions.
People with health problems (health problems including serious illness, chronic illness, medical conditions or any other situation related to physical or mental health that prevents equal participation in study programmes or work activities)	A statement from an employee of a medical institution confirming an illness/diagnosis that prevents equal participation in study programmes or work activities under the same conditions.
People who experience cultural differences (lack of knowledge of a foreign language and fear of cultural differences, migrants or refugees, people belonging to a national or ethnic minority, sign language users, etc.).	• A document proving the status of a migrant or refugee; • Medical certificate about hearing impairment (for the applicant or a relative), which results in the use of sign language; • Psychologist's report on fear of cultural differences; • etc.
People facing social barriers (low social skills, (ex-)convicts, (ex-)drug or alcohol addicts, etc. As well as obstacles due to family circumstances - single parents, guardians, orphans, people living in institutional care, etc.).	• Official documents proving the status of a single parent, guardian, orphan, etc. status; • Documents confirming social exclusion.
People facing economic barriers (low standard of living, low income, students who have to work to support themselves, poverty, debt, etc.).	Certificate of personal/family income for the last 3 months.
People experiencing discrimination (related to gender, age, ethnicity, religion, beliefs, sexual orientation, disability, etc.)	University psychologist's statement about the case of experienced discrimination.
